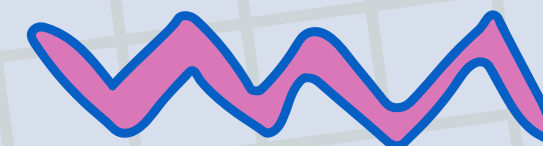


# A Message from our CEO

**New Laws on the Way**

During World Social Work Week on 17 March, the government marked significant progress in children's social care reform, with a bill moving through parliament that – subject to Royal Assent – will enshrine reforms in legislation.

**Stronger Protection for Children**

The government also published a revised Children's Social Care National Framework and an updated Working Together to Safeguard Children, which includes learning from serious safeguarding cases, tackling discrimination in safeguarding practices, and improving responses to child sexual abuse and domestic abuse.
